Kaniva Streetscape **KEY RECOMMENDATIONS**

Kaniva is located on the busy Western Highway, and as the first / last town in 🛛 📻 WINDMILL GARDEN Victoria from South Australia it is an important gateway to the Wimmera Mallee region.

The traffic engineering and landscape design is intended to improve liveability, safety and functionality for the local community and visitors to the town.

New and refurbished street furniture, a new shade structure, lighting, new footpath pavement, shade trees and a fresh planting palette is proposed within the streetscape to improve and complement the townscape character of Kaniva.

WINDMILL AREA

A BANNER POLES

Banner poles are proposed within the median at both ends of the central activities area, at the Madden Street and Baker Street intersections.

B COMMERCIAL HOTEL FORECOURT

Proposed shade tree, garden beds, heritage lights and café barriers to improve shade and amenity in outdoor dining area adjoining the hotel.

C KANIVA SIGN

Proposed high-profile township identity sign on two sides of the windmill – refer to precedent images for signage concept.

Note: Kaniva sign subject to structural engineering design.

D PLAYGROUND

Enlarge existing playground area, provide new rubber softfall surfacing, concrete edging and fence. Review play equipment, select new equipment with a sheep theme. Play equipment to be selected for the toddler age-group.

Re-design the windmill garden to increase outdoor re-aligning the pedestrian path to the roundabout, provision of additional irrigated lawns and new gard to improve shade and amenity. Locate new garder and physical separation to the roundabout / traffic I Garden plaque.

F MEDIAN SCULPTURES


A series of painted pic-perf (perforated steel) spiral cylinder sculptures to 2,000 - 2,500 mm high are proposed within the median strip with key agricultural images of Kaniva including grain, sheep and a windmill. The sculptures are intended to provide visual interest within the median and . Refer to precedent images for sculpture concept.







BLOCK 1

G POST OFFICE FORECOURT

Our design creates an improved gathering space within the streetscape to encourage people to meet and linger. Replace the existing arbour with a painted, steel-framed arbour, provide high quality feature paving with steel paving art, seating, a picnic table, lighting and garden bed planting. Opportunity for new art installation e.g. flock of sheep or steel paving artwork. The 'inland sea' and the importance of underground water to the district were raised as possible art themes.

H UNSIGNALISED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

Re-design existing pedestrian crossing to comply with AS 1428.1-2009 Design for Access and Mobility. Re-align to avoid tree removal. Increase width of kerb outstand, provide feature paving, seating and garden bed planting.

SIGNALISED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

Re-design existing pedestrian crossing to comply with AS 1428.1-2009 Design for Access and Mobility. Provide pedestrian operated signals across the arterial road lanes and zebra / wombat crossing on service roads to improve pedestrian safety.

WIDEN FOOTPATH

Proposed re-alignment of kerb adjoining Heartfelt Café to increase footpath width and provide additional space for outdoor dining.

K REMOVE MEDIAN BREAKS

Remove median breaks to improve pedestrian and vehicle safety.

TREE BAYS / OUTSTANDS

Proposed tree bays and outstands to cater for large canopy trees in the streetscape. Consider using tree cells or tree pits to support long term growth / establishment of trees.

Proposed feature tree planting - Ulmus parvifolia 'Todd' (Chinese Elm).

MEDIAN PLANTING

Roses to continue to be used as feature planting w red-flowering groundcover Roses (to match existing each block and highlight pedestrian crossings.

Use hardy bladed plants / groundcovers throughou beds to reduce ongoing maintenance and watering median including Westringia 'Mundi', Lomandra 'Ta Coral'. Remove Diosma plants.

Replace median strip irrigation system with new dri

Install a temporary post and PVC-coated plain wire to restrict unauthorised access / crossing of the me plants to establish.

No tree planting is proposed in the median.

N OUTDOOR PUPPET THEATRE

Provide open pavement space for outdoor puppet art installation.

BLOCK 2

P UNSIGNALISED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

Provide an unsignalised pedestrian crossing mid-way between Baker and Dungey Street to improve pedestrian access and safety. Kerb outstands are proposed at both ends to improve pedestrian safety / refuges.

Q LONG VEHICLE PARKING

2 no. long vehicle parking bays are proposed along the southern service road to encourage visitors to stop in Kaniva. Convert 2 no. 45 degree angle car parking bays to parallel parks. The existing service lane is wide enough to provide parallel parking on both sides.

Re-align kerbs to improve traffic management.

BLOCK 3

R SLIP LANE

Provide a slip lane and signage to facilitate long vehicle access to the service road and long vehicle parking bays proposed in in Block 2.

S MEDIAN STRIPS

The existing Ironbark trees in the median create a unique entry statement that we suggest is further developed. Provide infill Ironbark planting to reinforce existing trees. Provide solar-powered up lighting to illuminate selected median trees.

Consider widening the median strips in Block 3 to increase the root zone around the existing trees. The service lane width may be reduced to 4 metres.

Irrigated lawn is proposed in the median to create an attractive green entrance.



GENERAL NOTES

- Provide two electric vehicle (EV) charging stations within the main street. Possible locations include at Kaniva Community Roadhouse or near the public toilets on Madden Street.

- Provide accessible parking throughout the streetscape.

- Restore and re-position existing high quality cast iron furniture including seats, bollards and light posts. Restore and re-paint cast iron furniture components. Replace seat slats.

- Provide new rubbish and recycling bin surrounds with custom logo relevant to Kaniva / township branding.

- Provide new picnic tables with custom logo.

- Re-use existing tree surrounds for new tree planting.

- Consider temporary fencing along median strip garden beds to restrict pedestrian crossing 🗖 while median planting is establishing


- Provide fixed / moveable café barriers with interchangeable banners. Opportunity for custom artwork / advertising to be displayed on banners.


- Undertake a signage audit. Ensure signage is informative, engaging and up to date. Remove unnecessary signage.


