

VISION

The vision of the CRG is that the play spaces of Edenhope celebrate the diversity of the community and provide safe places that are accessible and inclusive, that are connected to each other, offer a stimulating and engaging variety of activities, recognise and celebrate the environment, provide a destination that is iconic and are designed for all families

Revegetation. Provide alternative treatment and education surrounding the swale from Back Swamp to Lake Wallace. Opportunity to reframe drainage line to be a controlled asset to the park with frog monitoring and frog lifecycle art interpretation with play. Review existing fencing style. Planting to ensure an open woodland habit is achieved to avoid excessive shading of the existing frog habitat. Select vegetation from the local EVC Plains Woodland & Wetlands

Gathering. Provide a variety of opportunities for gathering and observation surrounded by a range of playful activities

Basketball court. Support existing goal post on 1/2 basketball with a surrounding fence to control ball movement. Reduce height of raised timber sleeper edge and incorporate seating into edge

Mound Slide. Incorporate mound slide/ slides for challenging play / iconic and symbolic with terrific views. Provide planting and steps up mound

Carpark. Formalise the informal carparking area. Engineering design for drainage and traffic solutions to be developed in future stages

Skate Park. Extend skate park opportunities with additional paved, parkour, steps and slopes

Toilets - Location of toilets to be adjusted with the consideration of adjacent buildings and sightlines - located with clear views / passive surveillance, carparking opportunities and connection to activities

Signage. Link style to streetscape style signage family - provide park name and directional signage to Lake Wallace & other playspaces

Connection. Provide sealed connection from Lake St to Elizabeth St

Remove and relocate existing shelter

Fencing - designed as a 'fencing family' - consider the aesthetic of the park and other fencing requirements
Proposed Streetscape retains existing carparking and provides additional long vehicle parking (2 bays) - both for trucks and caravans

Concrete pedestrian path

Reinforce existing vegetation with legacy trees in irrigated lawn for picnicking. Consider an arborist review of existing health and longevity of existing trees

Lush existing shrub and tree planting - combination of Cotoneaster, Laurel, Agapanthus, Prunus, Ash and Poplars - consider planting review by arborist

Play Activity. Opportunity to incorporate double flying fox 30m and senior multidirectional basket swing with seating and adjacent picnic facilities with shelter

Connection. Provide pedestrian connection throughout the park

Opening in existing fence to be filled in with fencing to match adjacent fencing

Senior Play Activity. Senior Play area including cantilever rotating swing and pommel 4 seat swing, climbing tower, trampoline and a variety of seating and gathering opportunities

Provide a range of inclusive picnic settings and seats throughout the park including rest areas along main path

Relocate Information Shelter & seat to a suitable location to be determined

Commonwealth Games Melbourne 2006 Fish Sculpture in steel safety fence to be relocated to a suitable location to be determined

Junior Play Activity. Junior Play area including accessible carousel, 4 seat rocker with back support, junior climbing equipment with slide, junior swing with toddler and joey seat, basket swing and a variety of seating and gathering opportunities

General Note of Amenity. Provide wayfinding & directional signage, bike racks, water drinking fountains, shelter/shade, artistic elements, lighting for feature/safety & ambience (precise location and opportunity for solar to be reviewed in the future stages)



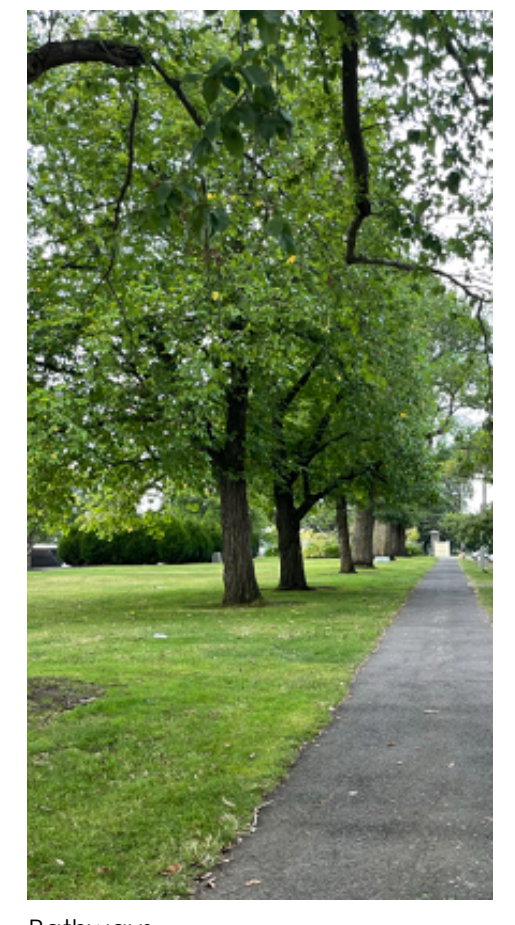

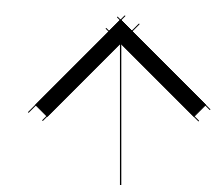
