If the Council favours the closing of the road described in the next paragraph, its concurrence should be given in writing to satisfy the requirements of the relevant legislation. It is suggested that the form of consent at the foot of this sheet should be used to provide the written concurrence of the Council under seal, or under the hand of the Chief Executive Officer.
