I want to ensure that those funds are rolled over in the budget .

Band Park.

I want to ensure funds for the erection of fencing for band park as per past budgets remain in the budget .

I want to ensure funds are in the budget to carry out the motion on 19 May 2016.

That we put up a board at the big fish stating how it got there and what it is about.

I want to ensure the funds are there to support the motion completing the entrance to Henley Park and that if the pillars are rendered to a colour that the cricket panel committee chose the colour in keeping with the cricket panels.

This is supported by the motion on 21 July 2016

That

1 Council removes the inner pillars of the Rushton Memorial Gates to improve traffic flow in and out of Henley Park.

2 Council render the remaining pillars of the Rushton Memorial Gates.

The widening has already occurred

The plaque remains to be put back up as does the rendering.

I want to ensure that the playground equipment that was removed after the playground audit be replaced in consultation with the various communities. I believe there are unspent funds to roll over.

7

I want an allocation of money for the restoration of the water supply to the Goroke library.

In the draft 16/17 budget page 28 it lists staff numbers will remain stable at 85.3 FTE through the following years

In the Draft 17/18 budget page 28 it list staff numbers for the 16/17 year as 87 FTE actual rising to 90.7 FTE for the 17/18 year then dropping back to 85.3 FTE for the 18/19 year.

While staff numbers are forecast to decline by 5.4 FTE in 18/19 the wages are still forecast to increase by a further \$214,000 and similar for the next year.

Could we please have clarification of these figures.
