Plant with: Asparagus, beans, Chilli, Chives, Tomato **Repels: Aphids, Flies**

Onion

Plant with: Beetroot, Capsicum, Carrot, Celery, Chilli, Cucumber, Lettuce, Parsley, Parsnip, Silverbeet, Spinach, Tomato, Turnip

Repels: Ants, Aphids, Cabbage **Butterflies, Caterpillars**

Mint



Plant with: Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Kale

Repels: Ants, Aphids, Cabbage, **Butterflies, Caterpillars, Fleas, Mice**

Radish



Plant with: Beans, Carrot, Cucumber, Sweet Corn, Cucumber, Lettuce, Parsnip, Pea, Spinach **Repels: leaf miners**

Wormwood

Plant with: Fruit Trees, Chickens

Repels: Cabbage Butterflies, Caterpillar, Fleas, Flies, Mice, Mosquitoes

GARDEN BEDS:

Wicking beds are easily maintained, use very little water, don't take much space and are quick to set up.

Wicking beds water plants from below rather than above. They're basically containers with water reservoirs at the base - like a giant selfwatering pot. Shuttles are an easily accessable option in the West Wimmera in building these wicking beds.
