Jacaranda mimosifolia / Jacaranda Feature / parklet tree - deciduous tree with attractive purple flowers



Robinia pseudoacacia 'Frisia' / Golden Locust Medium size feature tree - deciduous tree with fragrant white flowers, suitable for hot dry climates



Eucalyptus sideroxylon / Red Ironbark Infill planting in the centre median of Block 3 (Baker Street to Camp Street)



Callistemon `King`s Park Special` / Bottlebrush Small tree suitable for planting under powerlines in Block 3 (Baker Street to Camp Street)



Roses - feature plant within median retained at pedestrian crossings and feature.



Proposed median planting: Westringia fruticosa 'Mundi' intersections to maintain existing streetscape A tough and long-flowering groundcover with white flowers.



Proposed median planting -Lomandra 'Tanika' A hardy plant with fine, bright green leaves.





Proposed median planting - Aloe 'Mighty Coral' A contemporary low maintenance succulent with coral pink flowers in winter.

Flock of sheep sculptures to match existing streetscape art theme




Electric vehicle charging station (example)



Tree cell diagram to improve long-term growing conditions for street trees





Kerb modifications to provide passive irrigation to tree bays and median strips



Existing red brick paving - remove yellow brick edges to modernise look of pavement. Infill with salvaged red bricks.



Feature pavement option - G2 Paver 'Hearth' by SVC or similar colour / texture lightly exposed aggregate concrete.



Existing heritage light poles to be refurbished.



Ground mounted LED uplighting to centre median trees in Block 3



Uplighting to windmill



Internal uplighting to proposed sculpture post



Existing bench seats to be relocated and refurbished including repainting and replacing timber slats



Existing cast iron bollards to be repainted and relocated. Some new bollards required with chain link barrier between.



Existing tree guard. Remove tree guards from established trees. Refurbish guards to surround new trees.



Proposed bin with custom laser cut panel (example)



Removable cafe barrier with sleeve-in-ground and interchangeable canvas panel. Material types will vary for canvas / steel / glazing (example).

Rusty Trombone (RGB 198,85,40) (Proposed signage and sculpture colour)






Kaniva Entry Sign Material & Colours:


- Proposed 'Kaniva' sign installed on one side of a new medium-size windmill structure.
- Perforated steel ribbons, powder-coated / painted steel Rusty Trombone colour.
- 50mm thick 3D steel letters or 'Monument Grey' colour on front and galvanised finish on sides and back.
- Uplight town entry windmill and sign with ground mounted LED lights to provide a strong day and night visual identity.
- · The location and design of the entry sign will be the subject of further community and council consultation.

Perf Art Totems

Median Sculpture Material & Colours:

- · Tapered steel spiral cylinder illustrated with agricultural themes including grain, sheep, windmill, wheat, wool fibre and groundwater etc.
- Pic-perf image (custom design perforations)
- · Provide uplighting inside cylinder
- Rusty Trombone / Monument Grey colour palette

Option 1 (tapered spiral):


- · 2000-2500mm height
- 200mm dia. on top
- 600mm dia. on bottom

Option 2 (cylinder):

- 2000-2500mm height and
- 600mm dia. on top and bottom

The location and design of sculptures will be the subject of futher community and council consultation.


