**Key Ages and** Stages **Appointments** (KAS)

Maternal and child health nurses work in partnership with families to care for babies and young children until they start school. This service is free for all ages.

You will visit or be visited by a maternal and child health nurse at 10 key ages and stages of your child's growth and development along with any additional visits that are requested or required.

Additional appointments are made to ensure immunisation's are given in accordance with the funded (free) National Immunisation Schedule.
